Dear Taxpayer:

This is in response to your request dated Apr. 20, 2016, for information about your tax-exempt status.

Our records indicate we issued a determination letter to you in November 1946, and you're currently exempt under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(03).

We also recognized the subordinates on the list you submitted as exempt from federal income tax under IRC Section 501(c)(03).

For federal income tax purposes, donors can deduct contributions or gifts they make to you if the contributions or gifts are used exclusively for IRC Section 501(c)(3) purposes. If you solicit contributions or gifts for non-501(c)(3) purposes, the solicitation must include a statement that the contributions are not deductible for federal income tax purposes.

Specifically, IRC Section 6033(j) provides that, if you don't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked on the filing due date of the third required return or notice.

In addition, each subordinate organization is subject to automatic revocation if it doesn't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years. Subordinate organizations can file required returns or notices individually or as part of a group return.
